Notes Regarding Applications for Membership

1. Applications for membership must be accompanied by the appropriate fee but membership is not effective until formally sanctioned by the Executive Committee.
2. The granting of full playing membership or social membership is at the discretion of the Executive Committee. The type of membership granted may be reviewed by the Executive Committee if the members role in the Club changes.
3. All membership is subject to the constitution of the club and rules in force from time to time.
4. The club membership year for 2012 will run from the 1st of April to the 31st of March as per the GAA membership rules.
5. Membership and/or privileges may be suspended or withdrawn where a member is deemed to be in breach of Club rules.
6. Team mentor/coach whether adult or juvenile must take out full membership.

The benefits of membership of Naomh Olaf include

1. Ability to play Football and Hurling at all levels
2. Professional coaching of mentors and players, both male and female, from the age of 5 to adult level by the club's full time coach
3. Use of the bar and function room areas
