
Looking Ahead To 2023 - An update what's Happening on and off the pitches?

What happening re the **Astro Walls Extension**? - Planning was received but pending a winter 22/23 survey of the Brent Geese on the lower Benildus pitches – Survey to Finish by March '23 and then we have to re submit planning with the outcomes of this biodiversity survey request from DLRcoco.

Funding will be a combination of Grants and Fundraising. Watch out for the build a brick campaign!



- Design is underway to upgrade the clubs electricity infrastructure upgrade works will then take

- Once agreed we will be in position to finally, at last to upgrade our Floodlights to modern LED And charging points for EVs Electric Vehicles with help of sports grants.
- We have invested in **Portable Floodlights** to extend your training areas and use the likes of the lower Benildus pitches more where the drainage is better and give other areas a rest.


